

## Our Programs...

#### **TINY DANCERS AGES 2-7**

A range of class options specially designed to meet the needs of our littlest students, to help develop important life skills and a life-long love of dance. All classes cover fundamental skills to help students develop a strong technical foundation, to allow them the opportunity to pursue their dancing at an elite level in the future.

- Optional Mid-Year and End of Year Concert
- Optional uniform for Toddler Dance

#### AGE 7+ RECREATIONAL CLASSES

Recreational classes are perfect for anyone wanting to try dance for the first time, for those looking to get active, have fun and make new friends. Classes cater to all skill levels, with a focus on having fun.

- No minimum hours, days or class requirements.

#### PERFORMANCE TROUPES AGE 5+

Love dancing and performing on stage? Looking for a place to belong, with likeminded peers and a fun team environment? Our Performance Troupes (or "teams") are for students who want greater involvement and opportunities to perform with their friends. Designed with busy families in mind, our program fits everything onto just two nights a week.

#### **ELITE PROGRAM** AGE 7+

Our Elite training program is designed for extremely passionate, driven and dedicated dancers, who wish dance professionally or pursue a career in performing arts. Train in a healthy, encouraging environment with fellow, aspiring young dancers. Students are not required to be at an elite level to participate. However, must be highly committed, and willing to strive for excellence in all dance styles.

- Perform at community & corporate events
- Attend professional workshops & auditions
- Compete in 3-4 troupe competitions per year,
- Option to compete as a soloist
- Students attend set classes 3 days per week, and must attend minimum number of hours.
- High level of commitment and attendance is required to participate in performances
- Mid-Year and End of Year Concert Production
- Compulsory uniform
- 12 month commitment required

### CLASSES

#### **JAZZ**

Kicks, Turns & Jumps. Fast paced, highenergy class, covering everything from traditional Broadway styles, to the latest commercial moves.

#### **BALLET**

Ballet provides the technical foundation, required to excel in all other dance styles, and pursue a career in dance. Develop correct posture, alignment, strength and flexibility. We offer syllabus training and exams, from two highly recognised dance societies; ATOD & ATD

#### **TAP DANCE**

Have fun creating music with your feet

#### **HIP-HOP**

Popping, locking & breaking. A modern, popular & influential street dance style

#### **CONTEMPORARY/LYRICAL**

Interpretation and expression through free movement and choreography

#### **ACROBATICS**

Learn to safely perform your favourite tricks. Cartwheels, walkovers, aerials, handsprings, flips, tucks & more!

Note: Close physical contact between teacher & student is required for safety

#### **MUSICAL THEATRE**

Were you born to perform? 'Sing, Dance, Act' Become a triple threat and learn what it takes to cut it in the performing arts industry!

#### **TROUPE & ELITE CLASSES**

Work on advanced skills, rehearse and learn choreography for competitions and prepare for upcoming performances and events. Classes vary each week to ensure students are continuously being extended.

#### **TODDLER DANCE/ ME & MY GROWN-UP!**

A creative, expressive and fun introduction to dance, and a special way to bond with your child. (No uniform or dance shoes required!)

#### **PRE-SCHOOL DANCE**

Catering to all pre-school aged students, we offer both structured & fun class programs to develop co-ordination, confidence, musicality & imagination with creative use of props

#### **MINI GROOVERS**

Our high energy Mini Groovers class is jam packed with a mix of Funky Jazz & Hip-Hop

#### **COMBINATION CLASSES**

Covering jazz, ballet & tap these classes are highly recommended for young dancers to help develop a strong dance foundation

#### **TECHNIQUE CLASS**

Develop a good understanding of technique required to excel in other dance styles

#### **POINTE**

Students' aged 12+, who have undergone significant classical training, may go 'en pointe' when ready. Dancers must pass a prepointe assessment with our podiatrist to ensure they are developed, strong and have solid understanding of correct technique.



### CONCERTS & EXAMS



#### **MID-YEAR SHOWCASE**

Our Midyear Showcase is held locally at the end of Term 2. All students from Mini's onwards will have to opportunity to be involved and share with family & friends what they have been learning. Our Mid Year Showcase is always a great success.



Classical ballet exam work is taught as a part of the curriculum for all Mini & Sub-Junior ballet classes. We offer separate exam classes from Juniors onwards. Any student participating in these classes will have the option of taking a ballet exam. Ballet exams are usually held towards the end of Term 3. Exams can be very rewarding for the students and help them work towards goals to improve on technique. Each student receives a pin, medal or a trophy (depending on exam level/ syllabus) and is given a personal report of their progress. Our exams are conducted externally by two highly recognized dance societies: ATOD (Australian Teachers of Dancing) and ATD (Australasian Arts Theatre of Dance.)

#### **ANNUAL CONCERT PRODUCTION**

The CPD Annual End of Year Concert Production, is usually held mid to late November. Everyone given the opportunity to perform. We run professional theatre show, with great costumes, hair and make-up, to give the students a real theatre/ stage experience. Students are well prepared and have plenty of rehearsals to make it a fun experience rather then a 'scary' one. If you do not wish to take part please notify your teacher in the first week of the forth term. Parents will receive plenty of information about the show during the year.

#### **COSTUMES**

You'll be happy to know that at CPD all costumes are hired to the students, from our extensive wardrobe, at very reasonable rates. All costumes come complete and ready to wear for all performances. Our costumes are also available for external hire.

#### **Boys**

- Black CPD T-Shirt or plain white T-Shirt
- Black shorts, pants or tights

#### **SHOES**

- Pink (girls) or Black (boys) leather ballet shoes
- Tan tap shoes with buckle (girls) or Black lace up (boys)
- Tan jazz shoes- Optional\* (May be worn be not required.)
   (\*Jazz shoes may be required for performance troupe students)











#### **ACROBATICS & MINI GROOVERS**

#### **UNIFORM**

- Mulberry Leotard (see above) OR
- CPD Crop top or singlet (girls) or T-Shirt (Boys)
- CPD Black shorts
- Tights must be convertible for acrobatics

#### **SHOES**

- Hip-Hop: Any street shoes, runners, sneakers etc\* (\*Plain white shoes may be required for concerts)
- Acrobatics: Bare feet

#### **PLEASE NOTE**

- For safety reasons; no jewellery or watches are permitted
- · Hair must be tied back neatly for all classes.
- All dance shoes and general uniform items can be purchased directly from Energetiks Moorabbin.
- CPD Uniform and general uniform items can be purchased/ ordered directly through the studio.
- Please ensure dance shoes are purchased from a reputable dance-wear store, as department store shoes are not the required quality and my be unsafe.
- A Second hand uniform and shoe box is available at reception if you are interested in buying or selling second hand.

• As above OR CPD Crop top & shorts (\*Loose fitting clothing such as singlets & T-shirts are not permitted)

#### **HIP-HOP & MUSICAL THEATRE**

- Any CPD uniform OR as above for "Combo Class"

#### **HIP-HOP & MUSICAL THEATRE**

- Any CPD uniform including T-shirt
- A jacket or jumper is recommended for Musical Theatre during cooler months

#### LYRICAL/ CONTEMPORARY

- As above for ballet OR CPD Crop top or singlet & shorts
- Knee pads are recommended for classes

#### **SHOES**

#### JAZZ, TAP, ACRO & LYRICAL/ CONTEMPORARY

- Deep Purple leotard & CPD Black shorts OR
- CPD Uniform items; crop top, singlet, shorts etc.
- Loose fitting clothing such as singlets & T-shirts are not permitted for acrobatics classes
- Knee pads are recommended for lyrical classes

#### **HIP-HOP & MUSICAL THEATRE**

- Any CPD uniform including T-shirt
- A jacket or jumper is recommended for Musical Theatre during cooler months

#### **SHOES**
